Gentlemen:

We recently sent you an Invitation to Bid on the above mentioned specification.

This Addendum #1 provides for the addition of two (2) items in the Solid Waste Management Groundskeeping Specifications, Exhibit A, Specifications By Type page 26 as follows:

**Maintain irrigation systems as needed-**

The contractor will be reimbursed on a time and material basis. The contractor will be paid for the number of hours worked on the irrigation system. The hourly rate will be provided on the bid form in the unit price column at the line item maintain irrigation systems as needed. The cost of the material used will be reimbursed either from the discount from a published list price or at the contractor's cost.

**Fertilize turf areas-Areas-etc.**

Areas to be moved for all sites should be fertilized in March with a complete turf formulated fertilizer such as 16-4-8. Each application of fertilizer should be made at a rate of one (1) pound of actual nitrogen per 1000 sq. ft. Fertilization to be applied at the rate of 400 pounds per acre. Fertilize to be 16-4-8 slow release type. Fertilize should not be applied to drought stressed turf. Damage to drought stressed turf resulting from fertilize application during dry conditions will be repaired by contractor. Fertilize application should be planned for during March each year. Any damage to turf as a result of fertilize application other than drought damage will be the responsibility of the county provided the contractor has followed application direction as prescribed above.

**Exhibit A**  
**Solid Waste Management**  
**Groundskeeping Contract**  
**Specifications By Type**

**Fencelines**- Fencelines are located at HHW, Front Property Boundary and Leachate Basins. Fencelines to be chemically treated no greater than 12 inches from fenceline.

**Guardrails**- Guardrails extend along north and west boundaries of Section 3C and along north boundary of Recycled Material Recovery Facility (RMRF). Base of each guardrail post to be chemically treated.

**RMRF Concrete Conveyance and Outfalls**- Conveyance extends along north boundary of facility and in front of Sorting building. All structures to be chemically treated with Round Up or equivalent along concrete edges, weep holes and expansion joints. Treatment along edges should not kill vegetation to cause erosion during rain events.

**RMRF Turf**- Designated turf area to be mow/trimmed and curb edged. This area is prone to have concentrated litter and should be policed prior to completion of ground keeping activity.

**Green Waste Concrete Conveyance**- Conveyance runs along perimeter of Green Waste Processing. Conveyance to be chemically treated with Round Up or equivalent along concrete edges, weep holes and expansion joints. Treatment along edges should not kill vegetation to cause erosion during rain events.

**Maintain irrigation systems as needed**- The contractor will be reimbursed on a time and material basis. The contractor will be paid for the number of hours worked on the irrigation system. The hourly rate will be provided on the bid form in the unit price column at the line item maintain irrigation systems as needed. The cost of the material used will be reimbursed either from the discount from a published list price or at the contractor's cost.
